The Department of Education's Assessment Section is accepting applications from individuals to serve on various Hawaii State Alternate Assessment (HSA-Alt) committees. The committees include the Item Data Review Committees for ELA, Mathematics and Science and the Standard Setting Committee for ELA and Mathematics. Applications are being accepted from general and special education teachers, school administrators and community members who possess content knowledge in ELA, mathematics, or science or who work with students or adults with disabilities.

Members of the Item Data Review Committees will examine field test item data from this past year's operational field test administration of the HSA-Alt. Committee members will be asked to examine HSA-Alt test questions to ensure alignment to the content standards and to determine if barriers to access or understanding exist. The Item Data Review Committees will meet at the Diamond Head Annex on 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue in Honolulu (formerly known as the OCISS Annex).

Committee members will review HSA-Alt ELA and mathematics test questions that are ranked by difficulty and determine the "cut scores" +between levels of student performance.
