SUBJECT: Longitudinal Educational Information System Modernization

We are pleased to announce the modernization of the Hawaii Department of Education Longitudinal Data System (LDS) which will be known as Longitudinal Educational Information (LEI) Kūlia. Current LDS users will be able to access the new system using this link: lei.hidoedata.org effective January 14, 2022. Sharing the same identical data as LDS, LEI Kūlia introduces new intuitive dashboards combined with many of the most popular and useful reports currently in the LDS system. To help with the transition to the new LEI Kūlia system, LDS will be concurrently available throughout the current school year.

LEI Kūlia organizes attendance, behavior, academic grade marks, universal screeners, and assessment information both longitudinally and with current risk factors for individual students as well as groups of students. The new reports will allow our educators to follow data inquiry questions that reveal students' strengths, needs and can focus next steps for continuous improvement. Here are highlights of the new features in LEI Kūlia:

- Single-sign on profile access;
- Geospatial Analysis;
- Social-Emotional Learner survey data;
- Enhanced School Enrollment data includes student exits:
- School Administrator dashboards for Academics and Staff;
- State Smarter Balanced Assessments Math-Reading Correlation Plot;
- Dashboard analytics for Attendance and Behavior, Academics and Assessments, and Risk Factors data: and
- Program dashboards and reports for Comprehensive Literacy State Development Grant.
